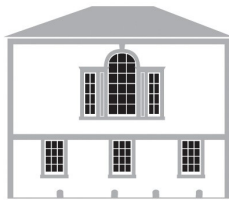

In 1680, David Drummond, 3<sup>rd</sup> Lord Madertie, instructed his heirs to ‘maintain for time coming’ the library at Innerpeffray for the benefit of young students. Scotland’s first free, public, lending library was born in that moment, and Madertie’s legacy is still inspiring people today.
