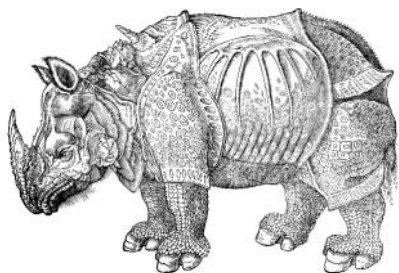

Keep history alive

Over 300 years ago a local benefactor established Scotland's first free public lending library. David Drummond, 3rd Lord Mader-tie, started a school for local children and left his books in trust for the benefit of anyone who wished to read. In doing so he created an institution that was to serve the local community until 1968 as a lending library, and today is a museum telling the story of the books and the people who borrowed them.

The Library of Innerpeffray was founded in 1680 and is run by the Governors of the Innerpeffray Mortification, an independent trust set up by the Founder's successors to continue his wish that the Library 'be maintained for time coming'.

The Library has had many patrons during its long history: with the common aim of helping the Library now and in the future—can you help us maintain this very special piece of Scottish history?
